#### I. THE RESULTS OF THE SERMON

- A. Direct Results: God received the Glory
  - 1. Peter was careful to praise only God, took none for himself
    - a. ACTS 3:12 "why look ye so earnestly on us?"
    - b. He turned their amazement into an opportunity to preach
    - c. It wasn't by OUR power, but HIS alone
  - 2. Thousands of people heard the Gospel of Jesus Christ
    - a. Remember again, the context right after Pentecost
      - i. 3000 people saved and baptized into church members
      - ii. 16 different regions named
      - iii. ACTS 2:5 "out of every nation under heaven"
      - iv. This was not a small thing done in a corner
    - b. They all heard the Gospel in their own language
    - c. It was heard around the entire city everyone knew
  - 3. And don't forget a lame man could now WALK
    - a. He is often a little left out of his own story
    - b. HE had been lame since birth never knowing the joy of running
    - c. Now he is walking and standing and leaping and praising God
- B. Indirect Results: Religious crowd gets nervous
  - 1. They were not a part of what God was doing and it threatened them
    - a. I'm sure many people who know me call me religious
      - i. It probably is okay to have a "religious" pastor
      - ii. BUT we aren't here for "religion"
      - iii. We are here to celebrate Jesus Christ, to know Him more!
    - b. <u>JAMES 1:27</u> "Pure religion and undefiled before God and the Father is this, To visit the fatherless and widows in their affliction, and to keep himself unspotted from the world."
    - c. Religion is what man does for God
    - d. Salvation is what He did for man
  - 2. They had things their way, using RELIGION to create and keep power
    - a. Much like the Catholics throughout time have done
      - i. <u>3 JOHN 1:9</u> "I wrote unto the church: but Diotrephes, who loveth to have the preeminence among them, receiveth us not."
      - ii. This is the attitude of the Nicolaitans
      - iii. REV. 2:15 "So hast thou also them that hold the doctrine of the Nicolaitans, which thing I hate."
    - b. Do as they say or you cannot go to Heaven
      - i. As if ANY sinful human has ANY say about Salvation!

- ii. Ridiculous! Man can't save himself, so God had to do it
- iii. And then God turns the administration of over to man?
- c. MATT. 6:27 "Which of you by taking thought can add one cubit unto his stature?"
- 3. Avoid anything that magnifies man and minimizes God
- C. The last result of Peter's sermon, was arrest (vs. 1)
  - 1. We know the RESULTS of the Sermon
  - 2. Let's the REASON for the Arrest, the REACTION of the Council
  - 3. The RESPONSE of the Disciples
  - 4. Finally, we'll see that it is all because of the RESURRECTION of the Lord

## II. THE REASON FOR THE ARREST

- A. The Jews were troubled
  - 1. That is no different than what happens today when Jesus is preached
    - a. Many are afraid to name the name of Jesus Christ
    - b. Many politicians end their prayers with only "amen."
    - c. Okay to talk of God and Angels on Facebook in general terms
      - i. You'll get a lot of likes! Hashtag "blessed"
      - ii. But you bring in Jesus and the Word of God
      - iii. And then see what happens to your secular friends
  - 2. The same is true with Modernists and Bible Doubters
    - a. They want to make themselves their own authority
    - b. They refuse to accept the BIBLE'S authority over their lives
    - c. If you don't stand fast on the Bible as God's inerrant Word
    - d. Then your "god" is of your own making
  - 3. <u>PHILL. 2:9</u> "Wherefore God also hath highly exalted him, and given him a name which is above every name:"
- B. And people WERE getting Saved (vs. 4)
  - 1. 5000 by this time! And that was cutting into the Sanhedrin's powerbase
    - a. Don't be surprised when the world persecutes Christians
    - b. <u>JOHN 15:18</u> "If the world hate you, ye know that it hated me before it hated you."
  - 2. And this is God's order for Salvation
    - a. ROM. 10:17 "So then faith cometh by hearing, and hearing by the word of God."
    - b. <u>EPH. 2:8</u> "For by grace are ye saved through faith; and that not of yourselves: it is the gift of God:"
    - c. <u>HEB. 11:1</u> "Now faith is the substance of things hoped for, the evidence of things not seen."
  - 3. But that was only part of the reason for the arrest of Peter and John
- C. The real reason is given by the name of those who arrived Sadducees (vs. 1)
  - 1. They were the bureaucrats of the Jewish religious world
    - a. The deep state, if you will

- i. They administered the state domestically
- ii. They represented the state internationally
- b. Believed:
  - i. The soul is not immortal; there is no afterlife.
  - ii. There are no rewards or penalties after death.
- c. And they HATED the doctrine of RESURRECTION!
- 2. They were specifically "grieved" by this teaching (vs. 2)
  - a. They tried to stop Jesus, but they couldn't no power
  - b. They thought they could stop Peter and John
- 3. But they didn't count on God stepping in! (vs. 8)

## III. THE REACTION OF THE COUNCIL

- A. They were hauled before the Supreme Court of the land (Sanhedrin)
  - 1. This court had over 71 members
  - 2. The most religious, most educated, and most wealthy of all
  - 3. This is the same court that condemned Jesus to the Cross
- B. They had only one question for them (vs. 7)
  - 1. And they GLADLY told them the name JESUS
  - 2. ACTS 4:12 "Neither is there salvation in any other: for there is none other name under heaven given among men, whereby we must be saved."
  - 3. BE IT KNOWN (vs. 10) and this man is the proof!
- C. Look at Peter's Holy Ghost inspired answer to the Council (vs. 8-12)
  - 1. He had Holy Boldness to speak FILLED with the Holy Ghost
    - a. All who are Saved are "indwelt" by the Holy Ghost
    - b. Some who are in sin "quench" the Holy Ghost
    - c. But we CAN be "FILLED" with the Holy Ghost!
    - d. We are commanded to!
    - e. <u>EPH. 5:18</u> "And be not drunk with wine, wherein is excess; but be filled with the Spirit;"
  - 2. He preached the Gospel to his accusers (vs. 10)
  - 3. He declared Jesus to be the Messiah (vs. 11)
  - 4. He presented to them the way of Salvation (vs. 12)
- D. The Sanhedrin didn't like it, but they couldn't find a way to argue against it
  - 1. They were speechless before the Holy Spirit Boldness of Peter
  - 2. They were powerless to defeat the fact of the lame man standing
  - 3. They marveled (vs. 13)
    - a. These were not learned men like the council
    - b. Not uneducated (read and write) but no college professors
    - c. Took knowledge often preached strangely out of context
  - 4. They were not convinced; they were flummoxed and incalcitrant (vs. 16)
  - 5. They WANTED to deny it but couldn't

#### IV. THE RESPONSE OF THE DISCIPLES

- A. The council threatened them, the council ordered them (vs. 17-18)
  - 1. Speak no further among the people (their secret fear)
  - 2. No teaching in the name of Jesus
  - 3. The threat is we will kill you.
- B. But look at the answer of Peter and John (vs. 19)
  - 1. We can only tell the truth about what we have seen and heard
  - DAN. 3:16 "Shadrach, Meshach, and Abednego, answered and said to the king, O Nebuchadnezzar, we are not careful to answer thee in this matter."
  - 3. Trust God! He will take care of us!
    - a. I hope there is no future pandemic but even if there is
    - b. We will NOT close the doors of this church
    - c. We did not before in COVID and will not in the future
  - 4. Listen to God FIRST
- C. The council was puzzled by this! They couldn't tell them not to listen to God
- D. So, they threatened them again and had to let them go (vs. 21)

# V. THE RESURRECTION OF THE LORD

- A. This is really all about the Resurrection of Jesus Christ
  - 1. I knew a young Catholic man once who got Saved
  - 2. But month after month, he refused to get Baptized
  - 3. Because he knew what that meant identifying with Christ
  - 4. Rather than the Catholic religion.
- B. What is baptism?
  - 1. A picture that demonstrates the Death, Burial and RESURRECTION
  - 2. We don't serve a dead Savior, but a Living Lord
  - 3. He came from Heaven, did no sin, and died in our place on the Cross
    - a. That WHOSOEVER believeth in Him should not perish
    - b. But HAVE everlasting life
  - 4. And then He rose again, the third day, according to the Scriptures
  - 5. And now He is alive forevermore, sitting on the righthand of the Father
- C. By God's mercy, He has held back His judgement that we deserve
  - 1. And by God's grace, He has made a way of escape for you and me
  - 2. Will you take it today?
