I. THE PRAYERS HEARD AND ANSWERED BY GOD

- A. When they prayed, the place shook
 - 1. That's it. That's all we need to know.
 - 2. How do WE shake this world with our prayers?
 - 3. How do WE appropriate some of that for ourselves?
- B. That's often the missing element. The missing ingredient.
 - 1. When the cake turns out flat, the cook forgot something.
 - 2. When the pie doesn't set, the cook forgot something.
 - 3. When we don't take the world for Christ, maybe we forgot something!
- C. And it's prayer. Corporate prayer!
 - 1. But there are some pre-requisites
 - 2. Some requirements to meet beforehand

II. THE PRAISE DIRECTED TO GOD

- A. This has become a pattern in the first part of the Book of Acts
 - 1. To see a church, to see the Apostles, to see EVERYONE
 - a. Give PRAISE TO GOD
 - b. Direct their praise to God (not one another or man)
 - c. They were THANKING the right person
 - 2. They LIFTED up their voice (not voices) to God (vs. 24)
 - a. They were UNIFIED in their praise
 - b. Not an UNCERTAIN sound
 - c. <u>1 COR. 14:8</u> "For if the trumpet give an uncertain sound, who shall prepare himself to the battle?"
 - i. Is this why some churches can't move forward?
 - ii. Some are praising God, and some are not?
 - iii. JAMES 1:8 "A double minded man is unstable in all his ways."
 - iv. If a man, why not a church?
 - 3. <u>JAMES 4:8</u> "Draw nigh to God, and he will draw nigh to you. Cleanse your hands, ye sinners; and purify your hearts, ye double minded."
- B. God's work was being done, His program put into action!
 - 1. They go to history and remind themselves how God had worked before
 - a. Look to PSALMS 2
 - b. SERVE the LORD with Fear (hallowing, honor, worship)
 - c. REJOICE with TREMBLING
 - 2. Remember, the whole place was shaken!
 - a. Maybe they're rejoicing with trembling was so great

- b. The building just joined right in with them!
- 3. They were FILLED with the Holy Ghost
 - a. Remember, if you're saved you have the indwelling Holy Ghost
 - b. And you can quench the Holy Ghost with sin
 - c. But you can be FILLED to OVERFLOWING too!
 - d. That's what we've been commanded to do! How we should live!
- C. They were ASSEMBLED!
 - 1. That's like an amplifier for praise, by the way.
 - 2. Ever heard a little tinny speaker play the 1812 overture?
 - 3. Then think about a ASSEMBLING a giant PA system!

III. THE POSSESSIONS OF ALL DEDICATED TO GOD

- A. Fellowship prevailed among them
 - 1. This is what is needed for all churches! ANY church! Needed TODAY!
 - a. Fellowship: "Partnership; joint interest; as fellowship in pain."
 - b. A "joint interest"
 - i. That isn't a passive "looking on with interest"
 - ii. That is a "expected dividend" type of interest
 - iii. I am INTERESTED in your Christian walk
 - iv. Because it AFFECTS me as a church member
 - c. You know the story of the Jericho and Ai!
 - i. Achan stole from God at Jericho
 - ii. JOSHUA 7:21 "When I saw among the spoils a goodly Babylonish garment, and two hundred shekels of silver, and a wedge of gold of fifty shekels weight, then I coveted them, and took them; and, behold, they are hid in the earth in the midst of my tent, and the silver under it."
 - iii. And then they fought against Ai and LOST!
 - iv. 36 men DIED because of Achan's sin
 - 2. It's easy to focus on the negative side
 - a. It's REAL Your sin affects other people
 - b. Usually, the one's you love most
 - c. But your SERVICE also affects other people!
 - 3. <u>HEB. 10:24</u> "And let us consider one another to provoke unto love and to good works:"
 - 4. <u>TITUS 2:7</u> "In all things shewing thyself a pattern of good works: in doctrine shewing uncorruptness, gravity, sincerity, (8) Sound speech, that cannot be condemned; that he that is of the contrary part may be ashamed, having no evil thing to say of you."
- B. They took CARE of one another (vs. 32)
 - 1. They cared for each other more than they cared for possessions
 - a. They had blessings common and trials common
 - b. Good tidings and setbacks

- c. This is not "giving to get" this is not prosperity
- d. There is NO mention of "profit" here ONLY NO LACK (vs. 34)
- 2. There's something wrong when a church becomes a business
 - a. This isn't your network, or your social club
 - b. This is the LORD'S church, and we are all members together
 - c. Let's love each other! CARE for one another!
- 3. Some gave MORE than others (vs. 35)
 - a. But it was "hand's off" giving not personal but corporate!
 - b. "I'll give you millions for a new building if you name it after me."
 - c. "I'll buy a church pew, but you have to put my name on it."
 - d. Once it was at the apostle's feet, it was the CHURCH'S!
- C. God points out one fellow that gave to his church (vs. 36 & 37)
 - 1. Barnabas, the son of consolation
 - a. Consolation "Comfort; alleviation of misery, or distress of mind; refreshment of mind or spirits; a comparative degree of happiness in distress or misfortune, springing from any circumstance that abates the evil, or supports and strengthens the mind, as hope, joy, courage and the like."
 - b. One of the true unsung heroes of the New Testament
 - c. The man called to the mission field with Paul
 - d. His name listed first, but then later gave way to Paul
 - e. Held out a second chance to John Mark after he left
 - 2. This is important context for next Sunday!
 - 3. Because we need to know about Ananias and Sapphira

IV. THE POWER IN WITNESSING FOR GOD

- A. It is a PRIVILEGE to speak God's Word to a lost person
 - 1. They begged for the blessing to be bold (vs. 29)
 - a. They intended to go out those doors and win the WORLD
 - b. They could see no barriers to their progress, no obstacles at all
 - c. They knew God was with them and they were READY
 - 2. List to their prayer!
 - a. They praised God for his Creation (vs. 25)
 - b. They remembered David and his trust in God (vs. 26)
 - c. They claimed Jesus as the Holy One of Israel (vs. 27)
 - d. They TRUSTED that God will do whatever He wants (vs. 28)
 - e. They prayed for protection and His unction (vs. 29)
 - 3. Why? To preach the Gospel! To Obey God! To win the LOST!
- B. No power in Hell or Earth can stop a rejoicing church
 - 1. How do we get close to God?
 - a. Give up things of the world
 - b. Seek revival in our OWN hearts
 - c. And REJOICE REJOICE REJOICE in the things of God

- 2. MATT. 16:18 "And I say also unto thee, That thou art Peter, and upon this rock I will build my church; and the gates of hell shall not prevail against it."
 - a. Gates do not attack they DEFEND
 - b. Churches seem to think this verse means "hunker down"
- 3. No, it means attack and TAKE TERRITORY AWAY from the devil!
- C. Governments and dictators have tried to destroy God's churches
 - 1. Satan has come against them!
 - 2. But he is POWERLESS against a rejoicing, God-praising, revived Church!
 - 3. Let's be one of those!

V. THE PLAN OF SALVATION FROM GOD

- A. They all experienced "great grace" (vs. 33)
 - 1. Grace is "God's Riches at Christ's Expense"
 - 2. Grace "Appropriately, the free unmerited love and favor of God, the spring and source of all the benefits men receive from him."
 - 3. Unmerited means "unearned,"
- B. Grace is the characteristic of God that provides a way of salvation
 - 1. <u>HEB. 2:3</u> "How shall we escape, if we neglect so great salvation; which at the first began to be spoken by the Lord, and was confirmed unto us by them that heard him;"
 - 2. <u>TITUS 3:5</u> "Not by works of righteousness which we have done, but according to his mercy he saved us, by the washing of regeneration, and renewing of the Holy Ghost;"
 - 3. If you are here and you're lost, without Christ
 - 4. You need His GRACE
- C. Put your faith in God.
 - 1. ROMANS 10:17 "So then faith cometh by hearing, and hearing by the word of God."
 - 2. Let me show you from the word of God how you can be saved
 - 3. And how YOU TOO can find His GRACE
