BIBLE WOMEN - DEBORAH - JUDGE OF ISRAEL

JUDGES 4:1-9

Many believe that the selection of a female judge was, in fact, a judgment against Israel. God uses whomever He chooses.

I. TIME OF OFFENSES

- A. Once again, Israel does evil in God's Sight (vs. 1)
 - 1. Ehud when Lefty stabbed Hefty (Chapter 3)
 - 2. The land was at rest 80 years JUDGES 3:30
- B. What character do WE have when the authority leaves?
 - 1. When we think no one is looking? (PSA. 11:4)
 - 2. God was watching and tried them (vs. 2)

II. TIME OF OPPRESSION

- A. The children cried out (vs. 3) a common cycle
 - 1. SOLD to a Canaanite king / Political wickedness
 - 2.900 Chariots the battlefield tanks of the day
- B. Under the boot of Sisera for 20 years (100-year cycle)
- C. (MIGHTILY) oppressed with power and great energy

III. TIME OF WEAKNESS

- A. No man stood up; they cowered away JUDGES 5:6-7
 - 1. No one willing to stand fast (PSA. 78:37)
 - 2. We are INSTRUCTED so (1 COR. 15:58)
 - 3. Because of HIM HEB. 3:14 / HEB. 6:19
- B. Barak did not hear from God, Deborah did. (vs. 6)
 - 1. Women can certainly hear from God
 - 2. But what a shame that no man ALSO heard!
- C. There was an army of 10,000 available! (900 chariots)
 - 1. Barak's answer only if Deborah goes (to war)
 - 2. God moved Sisera was defeated (vs. 15)

IV. TIME OF WOMEN

- A. Not only did God use Deborah, but also Jael (vs. 21)
 - 1. No man received glory in the battle that day
 - 2. When men won't obey, women will fill the gaps
- B. We need strong men and godly women to serve God
 - 1. God's Will be done: Whether through man or woman, strong or weak, confident or hesitant
 - 2. Anyone can rely on God's STRENGTH (2 COR. 12:10)
- C. <u>EPH. 6:10</u> "Finally, my brethren, be strong in the Lord, and in the power of his might."

- <u>PSALM 11:4</u> "The LORD is in his holy temple, the LORD'S throne is in heaven: his eyes behold, his eyelids try, the children of men."
- MIGHTILY (WEBSTER's 1828) "With great power, force of strength; vigorously; as, to strive mightily. Vehemently; with great earnestness."
- <u>PSA. 78:37</u> "For their heart was not right with him, neither were they stedfast in his covenant."
- 1 COR. 15:58 "Therefore, my beloved brethren, be ye stedfast, unmoveable, always abounding in the work of the Lord, forasmuch as ye know that your labour is not in vain in the Lord."
- <u>HEB. 3:14</u> "For we are made partakers of Christ, if we hold the beginning of our confidence stedfast unto the end;"
- $\underline{\text{HEB. 6:19}}$ "Which hope we have as an anchor of the soul, both sure and stedfast, and which entereth into that within the veil;"
- 2 COR. 12:10 "Therefore I take pleasure in infirmities, in reproaches, in necessities, in persecutions, in distresses for Christ's sake: for when I am weak, then am I strong."
