BIBLICAL WISDOM #1 - IDENTIFYING MANIPULATION

PROVERBS 3:13-35

Manipulators attempt to control another individual by inciting an emotional reaction rather than a biblical response.

I. CHRONIC CONDITION

- A. Manipulation everywhere (Internet, TV, Entertainment)
 - 1. "Control by artful, unfair, or insidious means."
 - a. Immigration don't you care about kids?
 - b. Abortion don't you care about women?
 - c. Climate don't you care about the planet?
- B. Usually involves intimidation (threats) to coerce
 - 1. School Yard: "I won't be your friend anymore."
 - 2. Christians: "Your sin is much worse than mine."
- C. We cannot judge hearts only actions (MATT. 7:16 & 20)

II. DANGEROUS DESIRES

- A. To exert unjust control over another (PROV. 29:13)
 - 1. This is Satan's tactic in the Garden (GEN. 3:5)
 - 2. Maligned another's motives / threatened loss
- B. Seek to entice guilt/shame/hurt/anger/fear/anxiety
- C. They want it badly enough to fight dirty (JAMES 4:1-3)
 - 1. They often know what they want is wrong / sinful
 - 2. Idolatrous Desire: Anything wanted enough to sin

III. EMOTIONAL ENTICEMENT

- A. The manipulator is NOT your biblical authority
 - 1. But uses "you should, you must, you can't," etc.
 - 2. They will portray THEMSELVES as the victim!
- B. Martha and Mary: A perfect Bible example LUKE 10:38-42
 - 1. Do you not CARE? (Seeking sympathy and guilt)
 - 2. She could have just asked Mary to please help
- C. Tactics: Accusations/Criticisms/Crying/Sulking/Why!?!
 - 1. Even Joseph and Mary tried it! LUKE 2:41-48

IV. FOOLISHNESS FORBIDDEN

- A. Proverbs (as usual) gives us the answer: PROV. 26:4-5
 - 1. Answer NOT: If they lie, don't tell a bigger one
 - 2. Answer NOT: If they yell, don't yell louder
- B. Meet emotional deceit with Bible fact Have I sinned?
 - 1. Are you upset with me about something God isn't?
 - 2. Answer folly as the folly deserves (PROV. 15:28)

- MATT. 7:16 "Ye shall know them by their fruits. Do men gather grapes of thorns, or figs of thistles?"
- MATT. 7:20 "Wherefore by their fruits ye shall know them."
- PROV. 29:13 "The poor and the deceitful man meet together: the LORD lighteneth both their eyes."
- $\underline{\text{GEN. 3:5}}$ "For God doth know that in the day ye eat thereof, then your eyes shall be opened, and ye shall be as gods, knowing good and evil."
- <u>JAMES 4:1-3</u> "From whence come wars and fightings among you? come they not hence, even of your lusts that war in your members? (2) Ye lust, and have not: ye kill, and desire to have, and cannot obtain: ye fight and war, yet ye have not, because ye ask not. (3) Ye ask, and receive not, because ye ask amiss, that ye may consume it upon your lusts."
- PROV. 15:28 "The heart of the righteous studieth to answer: but the mouth of the wicked poureth out evil things."
