## BIBLICAL WISDOM #2 - RESPONDING TO MANIPULATION

## PROVERBS 26:1-12

Once the foolishness of manipulation is identified, it must be dealt with directly in accordance with biblical truth.

# I. JESUS RESPONDS TO THE RELIGIOUS CROWD

- A. To the Pharisees LUKE 6:1-5
  - 1. Notice the "why" question Not interrogative
    - a. Accusation designed to embarrass and shame
    - b. No right answer if you accept the premise
  - 2. He gave it back to them and their "law" (vs. 4)
    - a. God never said you can't crack open a nut
    - b. If David could be excepted, so could God!
- B. To the Chief Priests LUKE 20:19-26
  - 1. Notice the planning and the spying (vs. 20)
  - 2. Notice the empty flattery ("teachest truly")
  - 3. Notice the binary trap! Both answers discredit.
  - 4. Speaks to THEIR responsibility "Render [THOU]"
- 5. Don't gripe about taxes and withhold your heart C. To the Scribes MATT. 15:1-9
  - 1. Another "why" question Not wanting an answer
    - 2. Jesus points out their hypocrisy
      - a. "Can't give you a ride to the airport, Mom, because my car is consecrated unto God."
      - b. Which is worse: Eating with unwashed hands or serving with uncleansed hearts?
    - 3. The Bible says HONOR thy father and thy mother

## II. JESUS RESPONDS TO HIS OWN

- A. Martha and Mary: A perfect Bible example LUKE 10:38-42
  - 1. Do you not CARE? (Seeking sympathy and guilt)
  - 2. Principle: Keep God the focus of your life!
- B. Joseph and Mary: LUKE 2:41-49
  - 1. Why hast thou thus dealt with us? (Emotion)
  - 2. Principle: More than anyone, they knew who He is
- C. Peter: JOHN 21:20-22
  - 1. Lashing out after a rebuke with "whataboutism"
  - 2. Principle: Mind your own business (MATT. 7:5)

## III. JESUS TEACHES US HOW

- A. He can judge hearts. WE cannot! (MATT. 7:16 & 20)
- B. Keep calm, think carefully to answer (PROV. 15:28)

- <u>MATT. 7:5</u> "Thou hypocrite, first cast out the beam out of thine own eye; and then shalt thou see clearly to cast out the mote out of thy brother's eye."
- <u>MATT. 7:16 & 20</u> "Ye shall know them by their fruits. Do men gather grapes of thorns, or figs of thistles?"  $\underline{20}$  "Wherefore by their fruits ye shall know them."
- PROV. 15:28 "The heart of the righteous studieth to answer: but the mouth of the wicked poureth out evil things."
