## BIBLICAL WISDOM #6 - THE POWER OF FASTING

## GENESIS 25:27-34

Fasting defeats the birthright of the "eldest" child (the flesh) and puts the younger (the spirit) into the driver's seat.

## I. THE STORY

- A. The husband and father
  - 1. Twenty years yet no children GEN. 25:20,26
    - a. But Isaac remembered God's promise GEN. 12:3
    - b. God also promised Isaac seed GEN. 17:9
  - 2. Isaac took it to God in prayer GEN. 25:21
  - 3. Prayer: (PSA. 102:17, ROM. 12:12, 1 THESS. 5:17)
- B. The wife and mother
  - 1. Couldn't understand what God was doing (vs. 22)
    - a. Best Option: Prayed for an answer
    - b. And GOD ANSWERED / Two sons (vs. 23)
    - c. The ELDER will serve the YOUNGER (strange)
- C. The sons and brothers
  - 1. Esau red as clay / the carnal man / wild man
  - 2. Jacob a plain man / the spiritual man / saved

## II. THE SALE

- A. Esau despised the birthright (vs. 34)
  - 1. Natural man and spiritual things (1 COR. 2:14)
  - 2. Seeking instant gratification in physical world
- B. Jacob sought the birthright (vs. 31)
  - 1. He was not clever or cagey spoke DIRECTLY
  - 2. God ratified the transaction (HEB. 11:8-10)
- C. Fasting ENABLED the sale of the birthright! (vs. 32)

# III. THE SENSE

- A. Two Natures: The Fleshly and the Spiritual
  - 1. The two are distinct (JOHN 3:6b)
  - 2. The two seek their own (ROMANS 8:5)
- B. There are two "men" in ever believer COL. 3:9-10

## IV. THE SUBJECT

- A. It "turbo-charges" fervent prayer (DAN. 9:3)
  - 1. HOW? The ruthless denial of the flesh
  - 2. WHY? To achieve a spiritual gain (HOSEA 12:3)
- B. It "magnifies" effectual prayer MATT. 17:14-21
- C. Effectual and fervent prayer is a MUST (JAMES 5:16)

- <u>PSALMS 102:17</u> "He will regard the prayer of the destitute, and not despise their prayer."
- ROMANS 12:12 "Rejoicing in hope; patient in tribulation; continuing instant in prayer;"
- 1 THESS. 5:17 "Pray without ceasing."
- 1 COR. 2:14 "But the natural man receiveth not the things of the Spirit of God: for they are foolishness unto him: neither can he know them, because they are spiritually discerned."
- HEB. 11:8-10 "By faith Abraham, when he was called to go out into a place which he should after receive for an inheritance, obeyed; and he went out not knowing whither he went. (9) By faith he sojourned in the land of promise, as in a strange county, dwelling in tabernacles with Isaac and Jacob, the heirs with him of the same promise: (10) For he looked for a city which hath foundations, whose builder and maker is God."
- <u>JOHN 3:6b</u> "That which is born of the flesh is flesh: and that which is born of the Spirit is spirit"
- ROMANS 8:5 "For they that are after the flesh do mind the things of the flesh; but they that are after the Spirit the things of the Spirit."
- $\overline{\text{DAN. 9:3}}$  "And I set my face unto the Lord God, to seek by prayer and supplications, with fasting, and sackcloth, and ashes:"
- HOSEA 12:3 "He took his brother by the heel in the womb, and by his strength he had power with God:"
- <u>JAMES 5:16</u> "Confess your faults one to another, and pray one for another, that ye may be healed. The effectual fervent prayer of a righteous man availeth much."
