BIBLICAL WISDOM #7 - DO NOT TURN BACK

PSALM 90:1-17

He knows our beginning, middle, and end. Don't allow the things you don't know to interfere with the things you do know.

I. THE MOUNTAIN

- A. God is there LUKE 9:28-35
 - 1. Definitely considered a "mountaintop experience"
 - 2. Count on flesh for bad ideas (sleeping vs. 32)
 - 3. God corrected Peter Only Jesus! (vs. 35)
- B. Foremost: Always give God the praise! (JOB 1:21)
 - 1. Blessings not earned by flesh (JAMES 1:17)
 - 2. It certainly isn't our power (MATT. 6:27)

II. THE VALLEY

- A. God is there 1 KINGS 19:9-18
 - 1. Would $\overline{\text{make}}$ sense if you started with the cave
 - 2. Elijah had forgotten God's hand
 - a. Fed by Ravens 1 KINGS 17:6
 - b. Fed by Unending Meal and Oil 1 KINGS 17:16
 - c. Used by God to raise the dead 1 Kings 17:22
 - d. Called fire down from Heaven 1 Kings 18:38
- B. In the valley, we only see the valley (vs. hilltop)
 - 1. Stay in the car KEEP GOING! (7000 in Israel)
 - 2. The view from the mountaintop reveals much!

III. THE HIGHWAY

- A. God is there LUKE 24:13-16
 - 1. They had business and were not paying attention
 - 2. They had cares and were not paying attention
 - 3. Even when we don't "see" Him, he's there
- B. Even when we run from Him (ACTS 9:5)
- C. Seek to see God's hand in your life (PSA. 77:10)

IV. THE BIWAY

- A. God is there LUKE 10:30-37
 - 1. He tells us go and do likewise (vs. 37)
 - 2. He fell, out of the way, off the beaten path
- B. No matter the way we left or stumble back LUKE 15:20
- C. He is always waiting for us to turn back to Him!

CONCLUSION: (ECC. 12:13) Reverence God. Keep His commandments.

- <u>LUKE 9:28</u> "And it came to pass about an eight days after these sayings, he took Peter and John and James, and went up into a mountain to pray."
- <u>JOB 1:21</u> "And said, Naked came I out of my mother's womb, and naked shall I return thither: the LORD gave, and the LORD hath taken away; blessed be the name of the LORD."
- <u>JAMES 1:17</u> "Every good gift and every perfect gift is from above, and cometh down from the Father of lights, with whom is no variableness, neither shadow of turning."
- MATT. 6:27 "Which of you by taking thought can add one cubit unto his stature?"
- <u>PSALMS 77:10</u> "And I said, This is my infirmity: but I will remember the years of the right hand of the most High."
- $\underline{\text{ACTS 9:5}}$ "And he said, Who art thou, Lord? And the Lord said, I am Jesus whom thou persecutest: it is hard for thee to kick against the pricks."
- ECC. 12:13 "Let us hear the conclusion of the whole matter: Fear God, and keep his commandments: for this is the whole duty of man."
