# BIBLICAL WISDOM #14 - BIBLE STUDY

#### 2 TIMOTHY 3:10-17

The worse evil men wax, the more we must study scripture. If not, we will never mature nor be furnished unto all good works.

### I. IT IS INSPIRED

- A. The one-and-only God-Breathed-Book 2 TIM. 3:16a
  - 1. It is opposite of (EXPIRE) "breathe out"
  - 2. Inspire means to "breathe into"
- B. It did not come by the will of man 2 PET. 1:20-21
  - 1. Private = Independent > Only one Interpretation
  - 2. Picture of a sailing vessel borne by the wind
  - 3. PNEUMATOLOGY: study of Holy Spirit (JOHN 3:8)

### II. IT IS INERRANT

- A. The only book that can claim inerrancy / infallibility
  - 1. All other books are written by sinful men
  - 2. The Bible is like Jesus (JOHN 1:1, 1 JOHN 1:5)
- B. The Bible is PERFECT SURE RIGHT PURE COMPLETE
  - 1. It is sure and righteous (PSA. 19:7-9)
  - 2. It is pure (PSA. 119:140) & true (PSA. 119:160)
  - 3. It is even above the name of God PSA. 138:2

## III. IT IS INCREASING

- A. It profits us in four ways 2 TIM. 3:16
  - 1. Doctrine "what IS right"
  - 2. Reproof "when we're NOT right"
  - 3. Correction "how to GET right"
  - 4. Instruction "how to STAY right"
- B. God blesses the humble (REV. 1:3, HEB. 11:6)

#### IV. IT IS IRREPLACEABLE

- A. It is spiritual food for the Christian
  - 1. It is milk to the newborn (1 PET. 2:2)
  - 2. It is break to the hungry (JOHN 6:33)
  - 3. It is meat to the hunter (1 COR. 3:2)
  - 4. It is sweeter than honey (PSALMS 119:103)
- B. Either a well-nourished or sickly and anemic child
- C. It is SUFFICIENT all we need to grow 2 TIM. 3:17
  - 1. Not some, not even most, but ALL good works
  - 2. No nourishment means no fruit PSA. 1:3

- EXPIRE (Webster's 1828) Latin expiro, for exspiro; ex and spiro, to breathe.
- <u>JOHN 3:8</u> "The wind bloweth where it listeth, and thou hearest the sound thereof, but canst not tell whence it cometh, and whither it goeth: so is every one that is born of the Spirit."
- $\underline{\text{JOHN 1:1}}$  "In the beginning was the Word, and the Word was with  $\underline{\text{God}}$ , and the Word was  $\underline{\text{God}}$ ."
- $\underline{1}$  JOHN 1:5 "This then is the message which we have heard of him, and declare unto you, that God is light, and in him is no darkness at all."
- <u>PSALM 19:7-9</u> "The law of the LORD is perfect, converting the soul: the testimony of the LORD is sure, making wise the simple. (8) The statutes of the LORD are right, rejoicing the heart: the commandment of the LORD is pure, enlightening the eyes. (9) The fear of the LORD is clean, enduring for ever: the judgments of the LORD are true and righteous altogether."
- PSALM 119:140 "Thy word is very pure: therefore thy servant loveth it."
- <u>PSALM 119:160</u> "Thy word is true from the beginning: and every one of thy righteous judgments endureth for ever."
- REV. 1:3 "Blessed is he that readeth, and they that hear the words of this prophecy, and keep those things which are written therein: for the time is at hand."
- HEB. 11:6 "But without faith it is impossible to please him:
  for he that cometh to God must believe that he is, and that he
  is a rewarder of them that diligently seek him."
- $\underline{1}$  PET. 2:2 "As newborn babes, desire the sincere milk of the word, that ye may grow thereby:"
- $\underline{\text{JOHN 6:33}}$  "For the bread of God is he which cometh down from heaven, and giveth life unto the world."
- 1 COR. 3:2 "I have fed you with milk, and not with meat: for hitherto ye were not able to bear it, neither yet now are ye able."
- <u>PSALMS 119:103</u> "How sweet are thy words unto my taste! yea, sweeter than honey to my mouth!"
