20200813 – THE FRUITFULNESS OF A SERVANT

The Calvary Road – Romans 12:9-21

<u>Challenge</u>: Keep our humble brokenness, filled with Him, walking in fellowship to produce fruit! <u>Points:</u> Not Conformed, New Creature, Next Choice, (it's) Never Clearer, (that we) Need Christ

I. NOT CONFORMED

- A. These are often referred to as the "Marks of a True Christian"
 - 1. This is a message for everyone but particularly those who sit here
 - a. On the threshold of (shall we say) agency
 - b. I won't say adulthood or majority the world has a definition
 - c. In our nation, we enjoy the sovereign franchise at 18 years old
 - d. But agency... an individual actor, morally responsible to God
 - e. No longer under Parents in exactly the same way as before
 - f. Soon to start a life perhaps in marriage AGENCY
 - 2. Just look at vs. 11 and think about how much of life that touches
 - a. Not slothful in business
 - b. Fervent in spirit
 - c. Serving the Lord
 - 3. That's what a servant does: Serves
 - 4. Isn't He worthy of all honor and praise?
 - a. He came to Earth for you
 - b. He died on a cross for you
 - c. He rose from the grave for you
 - d. He's coming again for you!
 - 5. 1 Corinthians 15:20 "But now is Christ risen from the dead, and become the firstfruits of them that slept."
- B. Romans 12 often preached to young people but notice 2 parts!
 - 1. First see vs. 1 your BODY (physical)
 - a. 1 Corinthians 9:27 "But I keep under my body, and bring it into subjection: lest that by any means, when I have preached to others, I myself should be a castaway."
 - b. That flesh has WAR in its members
 - i. James 4:1 "From whence come wars and fightings among you? come they not hence, even of your lusts that war in your members?"
 - ii. Even in your little toe
 - 2. Second see vs. 2 your mind (soul)
 - a. Not conformed but transformed
 - i. Not pressed into their mold!
 - ii. Transformed means "altered completely"
 - b. The transformational part relates to the renewing of the mind
 - c. Not the sacrifice of the body isn't that interesting

- 3. That renewing of the mind is called "sanctification"
 - a. That that is the transformational process that PROVES
 - b. Good / Acceptable / Perfect will of God
- C. Profitable Servants
 - 1. Matthew 25:20 Gained 5 more
 - a. This was what is called "profit"
 - b. Profit is the gain over the required costs
 - i. It is the difference between cost and price
 - ii. Somebody explain to me again Christ was a communist.
 - iii. Looks like capitalism to me!
 - c. He was congratulated (vs. 21) for the PROFIT
 - 2. But there was one who was NOT congratulated (vs. 24-26)
 - a. There's that word "slothful" again
 - b. You know, the world is run by tired people
 - c. There's darkness again too (vs. 30) fellowship with the Light
 - 3. There's an economic parallel to cost / overhead in servanthood
 - a. Remember anything above overhead is profit?
 - b. We have a word for "overhead" we call it "duty"
 - c. Duty is our "reasonable service"
 - d. IN OTHER WORDS to present our body a living sacrifice
 - That's just reasonable service in God's eyes
 - ii. May I say: That's the bare minimum of what He expects
 - iii. Oh! He's worthy of so much more!
 - 4. Let's be not conformed because He made us into a New Creature

II. NEW CREATURE

- A. 2 Corinthians 5:17 "Therefore if any man be in Christ, he is a new creature: old things are passed away; behold, all things are become new."
 - 1. We've covered a lot of ground so far
 - a. We are to walk in the Light
 - b. We are to be ruled by Peace
 - c. We are broken and humble
 - d. We have a constant choice to have an overflowing cup
 - e. And now we are to be profitable servants FRUITFUL!
 - 2. It's all about the NEXT choice we make... and the next one... and the next
 - 3. John 15:4 "Abide in me, and I in you. As the branch cannot bear fruit of itself, except it abide in the vine; no more can ye, except ye abide in me. (5) I am the vine, ye are the branches: He that abideth in me, and I in him, the same bringeth forth much fruit: for without me ye can do nothing."
 - 4. Ever see cut an apple tree branch off? Grow any fruit?
 - 5. No, because it wasn't connected to the tree

- a. Maybe we could say it wasn't in FELLOWSHIP to the tree
- b. See what I did there? It's all coming together!
- B. If we are new creatures, then we should do new things
 - 1. Testimony
 - 2. When I was lost, a different person (DWI, rebellion, drugs, rock, etc.)
 - 3. After I got Saved, things began to change (new job, new haircut, mouth)
- C. And now I want to be a profitable servant for Him to produce FRUIT
- D. But I have to make the next choice

III. NEXT CHOICE – I CORINTHIANS 3:10-15 (GO FAST)

- A. Gold, Silver, and Precious Stones
 - 1. Obviously not talking about Salvation here (vs. 15)
 - 2. What if this will make up the crowns we may cast at His feet?
 - a. Will these be the many crowns on His head when He comes?
 - b. What sort of crown am I making Him? Or WILL I make Him?
 - c. Our service MATTERS! Our heart MATTERS!
 - 3. This is the treasure in heaven that will endure!
 - 4. Send it on ahead! Ship it now!
- B. Wood, Hay, and Stubble
 - 1. Let me disabuse you of one notion: These are not sin (vs. 12)
 - 2. We don't build sinful works on the Foundation of Jesus Christ
 - a. There is no need for a judgement of sinful work
 - b. Romans 8 says that God has ALREADY condemned sin in the flesh!
 - 3. What if not the needs of life? God says any who won't provide for his own has denied the faith and is worse than an infidel
 - 4. What are these? Wood. Hay. Stubble.
 - 5. May I call them Time Wasters?
 - a. You know what they are in YOUR life, no need to start naming...
 - b. Let this be your measure: What will it mean in eternity?
 - c. Time is short!
 - d. VERY short!
- C. Use this precious time don't wait I Corinthians 7:29-35 (GO FAST)
 - 1. Time is short (vs. 29)
 - 2. This world is passing away (vs. 31)
 - 3. This is not a snare (vs. 35) or an indictment this is an OPPORTUNITY!
 - a. You say, but I'm single God knows that.
 - b. Go to sleep like Adam did and wait for God (I did)
 - c. Distraction is not a bad word simply means dividing of attention
 - d. So Attend the Lord without distraction now
 - e. And serve the Lord with your family later!
 - 4. And drop those time wasters like a hot rock!
 - 5. The need was NEVER more clear!

IV. NEVER CLEARER

- A. WWII Paratroopers
 - 1. Standing at ready positions Green light! Go!
 - a. The young person today is dropping into one of the most deadly spiritual battlefields that the world has ever known
 - b. Evil men and seducers....
 - c. As the time of Noah...
 - 2. The contrast between the Bible and World has never been more clear
 - a. At least not in my lifetime or (I daresay) my parents' lifetimes
 - b. This world will not be getting any better until the Rapture
 - c. And I don't believe we have much time left
 - 3. I am no profit of doom but my prayers have changed of late
 - a. When I see my nation, my AMERICA, flying apart at the seams
 - b. When I see my flag called racist, military racist, police racist
 - i. My dad was a highway patrolman a weight inspector
 - ii. He served with some of the first integrated Marine (Korea)
 - iii. I grew up with his graduation photos on the wall
 - c. It breaks my heart to see the America left to you
 - d. And I've begun to pray "how long?"
- B. Shine His Light
 - 1. We should shine brighter the darker the night
 - 2. We should walk in the light, as HE is in the light
 - 3. Lord increase my burden for souls!
 - 4. I long to be fruitful servant!
 - a. We read stories of Jonathan Edwards, Moody, and the like
 - b. I'm not commenting on their doctrine, but their hearts
 - c. There was a day that they sat on the threshold of agency
 - d. What did THEY choose to do with it?
- C. To be a servant, we need a master
- D. To be a Christian, we need Christ

V. NEED CHRIST

- A. Profit is above the cost? What was the cost He paid?
 - 1. Could I ever repay Him?
 - 2. No more than if I could have purchased my own Salvation
 - a. Is there anything too large He could ask me to give up?
 - b. Is there anything too great He could ask me to do?
 - c. Is there anything too much He could ask me to give?
- B. He is such a great Lord
 - 1. He calls us His friends
 - 2. He calls us His sheep
 - 3. He calls us joint heirs with Him

- 4. He engrafts us into the commonwealth of Israel
- 5. He gives us the power to become the sons of God
- 6. He calls us to SERVE Him
- 7. The servant is not greater than the master
 - a. Matthew 10:24 "The disciple is not above his master, nor the servant above his lord."
 - b. Philippians 2:8 "And being found in fashion as a man, he humbled himself, and became obedient unto death, even the death of the cross."
- C. Will you fellowship with Him as a servant?
- D. Are you ready to say Amen to God in whatever He is asking today?
