FAMILY MATTERS #1 - HEART OF THE FAMILY

JOSHUA 24:14-18

Nations, Churches, and Families all have "personalities." Some are kind, loud, peaceful, loving, hateful, or mean at heart.

- I. JOSHUA'S DECLARATION COMES FROM THE HEART JOSHUA 24:15
 - A. Disagreement "And if it seem evil unto you..."
 - 1. Joshua was on his deathbed (vs.29)
 - 2. God had already spoken (EXO. 20:3)
 - B. Decision "...choose you this day..."
 - 1. The choice is plain only TWO choices
 - 2. The choice is urgent MUST be made TODAY
 - C. Distinction "...but as for me and my house..."
 - 1. Joshua will not go with the crowd (2 COR. 6:17)
 - 2. Joshua is willing to stand alone (TITUS 2:14)
 - D. Determination "...we will..."
 - 1. Many in our world refuse to decide! (JAMES 5:12)
 - 2. STAND for something / Don't faint (1 COR. 16:13)
 - 3. Leaders make decisions (no decision = decision)
 - E. Direction "...serve the Lord."
- II. GOD CARES ABOUT THE HEART LUKE 1:17
 - A. God enumerated THREE duties for John the Baptist
 - 1. We think about the third, sometimes the second
 - 2. But what did God say FIRST? Hearts of fathers.
 - 3. What did John the Baptist preach? REPENT YE!
 - 4. Repentance is heart-based 2 COR. 7:10
 - B. God ponders / sifts / DISCERNS the innermost man
 - 1. Bible divides HEB. 4:12 / (PROV. 21:2)
 - 2. Man looks to the outward, God upon the heart
- III. FAMILY TROUBLES COME FROM THE HEART
 - A. No matter the issue it is an issue of the HEART
 - 1. Lies and Falseness MATT. 15:18 (Distant Heart)
 - 2. Adulteries MATT. 15:19 (Evilness of Heart)
 - 3. Divorce MATT. 19:8 (Hardness of Heart)
 - B. Solution? Go straight to the HEART! PROV. 23:26
 - 1. The heart cannot be taken, must be given
 - 2. Must live as an open example (OBSERVE my ways)
 - 3. A godly family is the highest prize (MATT. 6:21)
 - C. No godly family without Salvation first LUKE 19:1-10
 - 1. Love God with WHOLE heart (MATT. 22:37)
 - 2. A godly family forgiveness always (EPH. 4:32)

- CONCLUSION: The heart a family has results from a decision that is made and reinforced by all those within it. Changing the heart of a family requires Salvation, Forgiveness, Humbleness and DECISIVE LEADERSHIP.
