PROVERBS 15:33, 18:12, 29:23

Honor means "To revere; to respect; to treat with deference and submission." In the family, we must honor one another.

- I. Honoring Your God
 - A. He is the King and deserves our best 1 TIM. 1:17
 - 1. He is the Savior, the Lamb of God (REV. 4:11)
 - 2. He receives repeated praise (REV. 5:12)
 - B. He commands us to FOLLOW AFTER (an important phrase)
 - 1. Follow after Him (LUKE 9:23)
 - 2. Follow after peace and edification (ROM. 14:19)
 - 3. Follow after charity and preaching (1 COR. 14:1)
 - 4. Follow after USEFULNESS TO JESUS (PHIL. 3:12)
- II. Honoring Your Commitments
 - A. Your word is your bond EVEN with family MATT 5:37
 - 1. God requires that we pay our vows (DEUT. 23:21)
 - 2. True with God, why not His Children?
 - B. Sexual purity
 - 1. Honor marriage commitments HEB. 13:4
 - 2. Honor "lack" of commitments (1 COR. 6:18)
 - C. Love the Lord your God with EVERYTHING! (1 JOHN 5:21)
 - D. Do nothing "half-hearted" or "lukewarm" for God
- III. Honoring Your Spouse
 - A. Husbands: Marriage is not arm-wrestling 1 PET. 3:7
 - 1. (a) Love, (b) Listen, and (c) LEARN your wife
 - 2. Dwell according to knowledge (gain it first!)
 - B. Wives: God blesses your husband's leadership EPH. 5:33
 - 1. (a) Acknowledge, (b) Attend, (c) Accept decisions
 - 2. The word "see" means that it isn't automatic
- IV. Honoring Your Children
 - A. Parents must teach children about God DEUT 6:6-9
 - B. Honor with (a) Communications, (b) Chastening
 - C. But MOST OF ALL (c) Consistency (training a puppy)
- V. Honoring Your Siblings
 - A. Don't be a liar! 1 JOHN 4:20-21 (In Christ & at Home)
 - B. Practice GOOD manners (1 COR. 15:33) / (PROV. 21:4)
