## FAMILY MATTERS #13 - OBSTACLES OF THE FAMILY

## JAMES 4:1-12

God created marriage and the family for our good. The flesh, the world, and the devil puts many obstacles in our path.

## I. THE OBSTACLE OF PRIDE

- A. Selfishness
  - 1. Often called "following your heart" (JER. 17:9)
  - 2. We want to consume God's gifts upon our lusts
  - 3. Ask "amiss" Marriage/Money/Blessings (vs. 2-4)
- B. Worldliness
  - 1. Clean hands / Clean heart / Single Mind (vs. 8)
  - 2. Friend to world or close to God? (vs. 4)
  - 3. We must make our choice clear 2 COR. 6:17
- C. Pridefulness
  - 1. This is the devil's favorite sin (ISA. 14:13-15)
  - 2. James 4: Ask, humble, submit, draw nigh, weep
  - 3. The most dangerous sentence: "I deserve..."
    - a. Affairs, pornography, adultery
    - b. Divorce or emotional distance
  - 4. When we believe our "rights" are violated
    - a. Anger, rage, and bitterness
    - b. Sharpness, and cold-hearted language
  - 5. We "deserve" Hell but Jesus saves!
- D. Unforgiveness
  - 1. As important as our daily bread MATT. 6:12-15
  - 2. Further from God means further from family
- E. Prayerlessness
  - 1. When we believe "we have it all under control"
  - 2. Without humbling self for pray (2 CHRON. 7:14)
- F. Praiselessness
  - 1. When we believe "we are able by ourselves"
  - 2. Lack of praise makes the heart dark (ROM. 1:21)

## II. THE OBSTACLE OF PASSIVITY

- A. Prudence looks ahead and seeks to prevent PROV. 22:3
  - 1. Two times (again in Prov. 27:12)
  - 2. Don't let circumstances just "happen" to you
- B. Abraham and Sarai (and Hagar) GEN. 16:1-5
  - 1. God is "absent" from Abram's life for years
  - 2. They did not wait on God's promise
  - 3. He let his wife take the lead in the home
- C. No one else can seek God for you or lead your family
- D. The hearts of the children must be won PROV. 23:26

- <u>JER. 17:9</u> "The heart is deceitful above all things, and desperately wicked: who can know it?"
- <u>ISA. 14:13</u> "For thou hast said in thine heart, I will ascend into heaven, I will exalt my throne above the stars of God: I will sit also upon the mount of the congregation, in the sides of the north: (14) I will ascend above the heights of the clouds; I will be like the most High. (15) Yet thou shalt be brought down to hell, to the sides of the pit."
- 2 CHRON. 7:14 "If my people, which are called by my name, shall humble themselves, and pray, and seek my face, and turn from their wicked ways; then will I hear from heaven, and will forgive their sin, and will heal their land."
- ROM. 1:21 "Because that, when they knew God, they glorified him not as God, neither were thankful; but became vain in their imaginations, and their foolish heart was darkened."
