## FIGURES IN TIMOTHY #5 - THE VESSEL

2 TIMOTHY 2:19-23

Paul identifies two types of vessels. Honorable and Dishonorable vessels are determined by their usefulness.

- I. USEFUL VESSELS A. For CARRYING (watering can to garden), COOKING (feeding others), and KEEPING (storage - steadfast) B. We are all to be READY VESSELS in God's Hands!
- II. CLEAN VESSELS

A. On the INSIDE first MATT. 23:25-26

Only the BLOOD of Jesus LEV. 17:11 / HEB. 9:22
When clean on inside, outside will become clean!

B. On the OUTSIDE ISA. 52:11

This is separation from the world ROM. 12:1-2
Living a clean life before God and Man

III. HONORABLE VESSELS (Represented by Gold and Silver)

These are durable metals (value that lasts)
The child must be durable <u>1 COR. 15:58</u> / JUDE 3
B. These metals have a shine / hold their brilliance

- 1. The child of God should shine PHIL. 2:12-16
- C. These metals are beautiful (wedding rings)
  - 1. The child of God should be beautiful for God
  - 2. Not full of hatred/envy/jealousy/greed/gossip
- D. These metals are precious intrinsically valuable 1. We are precious to God MATT. 18:12
- IV. DISHONORABLE VESSELS

1. Hiding their light under a bushel MATT. 5:14-16

V. GOD'S FORMULA (vs. 22-23) A. Some things to avoid (vs. 23, also vs. 16) B. Some things to flee (vs. 22a) C. Some things to follow (vs. 22a) 1. RIGHTEOUSNESS - separated from the world 2. FAITH - relying on God / Holy Spirt / Bible 3. CHARITY - Love for God / Christ / Saints / Lost 4. PEACE - Not strife nor contention!
