## JAMES #10 - THE RICH WARNED

## JAMES 5:1-6

The wealthy among them were oppressing the poor (2:6-7). These verses condemn the unjust landlord and lender. Our riches are to be used in a Biblical and Christ-like manner.

- I. THE UNJUST RICH WARNED (vs.1)
  - A. Gaining / using riches: The accounting day will come!
    - 1. This sounds like America today
    - 2. We must live differently as good stewards
  - B. Many will howl and cry out in grief GAL. 6:7-10
    - 1. This is the law of sowing and reaping
    - 2. You reap AFTER you sow
    - 3. You reap MORE than you sow
    - 4. You reap WHAT you sow
- II. THE DOOM OF THE UNJUST RICH (vs.2-3)
  - A. This is a description of their riches
    - 1. They are corrupted and rusted (through non-use)
    - 2. They shall bite into the flesh (as fire)
  - B. See the folly of the rich (vs.3b)
    - 1. Abundant riches for the last days (of this life)
    - 2. But all will be left behind at death
    - 3. USE wealth to be rich with God LUKE 12:16-21
- III. THE SINS OF THE UNJUST RICH (vs.4-6)
  - A. Injustice towards the laborer (or helpless) (vs.4)
    - 1. Mosaic Law condemns Deut. 24:14-15 / Lev. 19:13
    - 2. Remember Israel in Egyptian bondage
    - 3. Their taskmasters made them labor to make brick
    - 4. God heard their cries and acted!
  - B. Living in luxury and extravagance (vs.5)
    - 1. The rich grow fat in body but weak with God
    - 2. The oppressed grow more and more poor
    - 3. This is everyday life in many corrupt nations!
  - C. They condemned and killed the just (vs.6)
- IV. THE CORRECT USE OF OUR RICHES
  - A. We are instructed to be good stewards 1 COR. 4:1-2
    - 1. Gain wealth honestly and use it for God's glory
    - 2. Every windfall or raise is an opportunity!
  - B. Invest in the best retirement ever known MATT. 6:19-20
