

JESUS THE MASTER TEACHER #3 - HE TEACHES ABOUT HIMSELF

LUKE 4:14-24 & JOHN 8:18

- I. HE DECLARES THE TITLES THAT HE BORE
 - A. He was a preacher LUKE 4:18-19 (MARK 1:14-15)
 - B. He was a prophet LUKE 4:24
 - C. He was a teacher LUKE 4:14-15

- II. HE DECLARES HIS RELATIONSHIP TO GOD
 - A. God was His FATHER JOHN 17:21-25
 - B. He was EQUAL with God JOHN 5:17-23
 - 1. But sent from the Father (as He sent the Spirit)
 - 2. Always doing the will of the Father (JOHN 4:34)
 - C. He and God are ONE JOHN 10:30-31

- III. HE DECLARES HIMSELF THE "SON OF MAN"
 - A. His favorite title for Himself LUKE 9:58 & 19:10
 - 1. He refers to His humanity (All God / All man)
 - 2. He became FLESH, He DWELT among us (JOHN 1:14)
 - B. Also, the EXALTED PERFECT example (DANIEL 7:13-14)

- IV. HE DECLARES HIS MINISTRY
 - A. To be a servant MATT. 20:26-28
 - B. To be the seeker of the lost (LUKE 19:10)
 - 1. To become the Savior of the lost
 - 2. To SAVE sinful men (LUKE 9:56)
 - 3. Sing it o'er again, Christ redeemeth sinful men!
 - C. To be the RANSOM PRICE for sin MARK 10:45
 - 1. Explain: A hostage held at a price for ransom
 - 2. Explain: A gold watch in pawn to be redeemed

- V. HE DECLARES HIMSELF WORTHY OF OBEDIENCE
 - A. We must lose our life in Jesus (MATT. 10:37-39)
 - B. What should we obey? Great Commission:
 - 1. Follow His example and teach MATT. 28:18-20
 - 2. Preach Gospel / Baptize Church Members / Teach
 - C. What should we obey? His Commandments:
 - 1. We will abide in His love (JOHN 14:15 & 15:10)
 - D. What should we obey? Confess His name:
 - 1. Three times: MATT. 10:32 / LUKE 12:8 / REV. 3:5
 - 2. He is worthy of our complete loyalty and trust!

MARK 1:14 - "Now after that John was put in prison, Jesus came into Galilee, preaching the gospel of the kingdom of God, (15) And saying, The time is fulfilled, and the kingdom of God is at hand: repent ye, and believe the gospel."

JOHN 4:34 - "Jesus saith unto them, My meat is to do the will of him that sent me, and to finish his work."

JOHN 1:14 - "And the Word was made flesh, and dwelt among us, (and we beheld his glory, the glory as of the only begotten of the Father,) full of grace and truth."

DANIEL 7:13-14 - "I saw in the night visions, and, behold, one like the Son of man came with the clouds of heaven, and came to the Ancient of days, and they brought him near before him. (14) And there was given him dominion, and glory, and a kingdom, that all people, nations, and languages, should serve him: his dominion is an everlasting dominion, which shall not pass away, and his kingdom that which shall not be destroyed."

LUKE 19:10 - "For the Son of man is come to seek and to save that which was lost."

LUKE 9:56 - "For the Son of man is not come to destroy men's lives, but to save them. And they went to another village."

MATT. 10:37-39 - "He that loveth father or mother more than me is not worthy of me: and he that loveth son or daughter more than me is not worthy of me. (38) And he that taketh not his cross, and followeth after me, is not worthy of me. (39) He that findeth his life shall lose it: and he that loseth his life for my sake shall find it."

JOHN 14:15 - "If ye love me, keep my commandments."

JOHN 15:10 - "If ye keep my commandments, ye shall abide in my love; even as I have kept my Father's commandments, and abide in his love."
