#### JESUS THE MASTER TEACHER #5 - HE TEACHES ON DISCIPLESHIP

# MATTHEW 16:24-27

#### I. DISCIPLESHIP REALIZED

- A. A position available to every person! No restrictions!
  - 1. All in general / ANY MAN in particular (vs. 24)
  - 2. The word "will" is operative, many "won't"
- B. The word (DISCIPLE) is used over 250 times in the N.T.
  - 1. It describes one who is a follower (v. 24)
  - 2. It describes one who is a learner MATT. 11:28-30

### II. DISCIPLESHIP REQUIREMENTS

- A. Must be done in God's order, not our own (MATT. 16:24)
  - 1. Self-Denial FIRST! TITUS 2:11-12
  - 2. Cross-Bearing SECOND GAL. 2:20
  - 3. Follow Jesus THIRD MATT. 4:18-22
- B. If any fail in the order or obedience to these three
  - 1. Not worthy to be called disciple MATT. 10:37-38
  - 2. Discipleship requires commitment (Ex. Olympics)

### III. DISCIPLESHIP REVEALS

- A. Disciples "loose" life in worldly things (MATT. 16:25)
  - 1. Does not live for Self / Wealth / Praise
  - 2. He becomes a Spring of Living Water JOHN 4:14
  - 3. One who is not thirsty does not need a spring
- B. Disciples "find" life in eternal things
  - 1. This is the abundant life JOHN 10:10
  - 2. Disciples live victorious and peaceful lives
  - 3. The crucified life (ROM. 6:6 / GAL. 2:20, 6:14)

## IV. DISCIPLESHIP REWARDS

- A. No ETERNAL profit in the worldly life (MATT. 16:26-27)
  - 1. Many build wood, hay, and stubble 1 COR. 3:11-15
  - 2. All works will be tried by fire
  - 3. We want to be profitable servants ROM. 12:1
- B. ETERNAL profit only in eternity (MATT. 6:19-21)
  - 1. What will matter then? Our career? Our house?
  - 2. Lay up treasures in heaven PILE IT HIGH!
  - 3. More focus on heaven changes the heart
- C. (JIM ELLIOT QUOTE)

- <u>DISCIPLE Webster's 1828</u> (1.) A learner; a scholar; one who receives or professes to receive instruction from another; as the disciples of Plato. (2.) A follower; an adherent to the doctrines of another.
- MATT. 16:24 "Then said Jesus unto his disciples, If any man will come after me, let him deny himself, and take up his cross, and follow me."
- $\underline{\text{MATT. } 16:25}$  "For whosoever will save his life shall lose it: and whosoever will lose his life for my sake shall find it."
- ROM. 6:6 "Knowing this, that our old man is crucified with him, that the body of sin might be destroyed, that henceforth we should not serve sin."
- GAL. 2:20 "I am crucified with Christ: nevertheless I live; yet not I, but Christ liveth in me: and the life which I now live in the flesh I live by the faith of the Son of God, who loved me, and gave himself for me."
- GAL. 6:14 "But God forbid that I should glory, save in the cross of our Lord Jesus Christ, by whom the world is crucified unto me, and I unto the world."
- MATT. 16:26-27 "For what is a man profited, if he shall gain the whole world, and lose his own soul? or what shall a man give in exchange for his soul? (27) For the Son of man shall come in the glory of his Father with his angels; and then he shall reward every man according to his works."
- MATT. 6:19-21 "Lay not up for yourselves treasures upon earth, where moth and rust doth corrupt, and where thieves break through and steal: (20) But lay up for yourselves treasures in heaven, where neither moth nor rust doth corrupt, and where thieves do not break through nor steal: (21) For where your treasure is, there will your heart be also."
- JIM ELLIOT QUOTE "He is no fool who gives what he cannot keep to gain that which he cannot lose." Jim Elliot wrote those words on October 28, 1949. A young man contemplating a life of Discipleship. He and his four fellow missionaries were martyred a few years later on January 8<sup>th</sup>, 1956. All were married, and four were fathers. One wife was pregnant. After the birth, her three-year-old was heard to tell the new crying baby, "Never you mind, when we get to heaven I'll show you which one is daddy."
