#### I. THE BETWEEN

- A. Read verse 22 & 23 with verse 25 to see "then"
  - 1. John was baptizing
  - 2. Jesus was baptizing
  - 3. A question arose!
    - a. Isn't that always the way
    - b. You'd think that everyone here would be happy!
    - c. The Gospel was being preached
    - d. Sinners were coming to repentance
    - e. And here came a question
  - 4. Now in the context here, this wasn't a simple clarification
    - a. No one was saying "so... I'm not sure I get it."
    - b. They weren't asking for more information
    - c. We will have to call this what it is: a division
    - d. See? It was "between" some of them (vs. 25)
- B. The Disciples and the Jews
  - 1. Just a guess but the disciples of John
    - a. Probably heard him point to Jesus as the Christ
    - b. Probably were excited about the Lord
    - c. But perhaps they were novices
      - i. Who were "fans" of John
      - ii. Who "knew" John's baptism was better than all others
  - 2. The Jews
    - a. They were likely the ones keeping track of numbers
    - b. Hey, I keep track of numbers too right after Leviticus!
    - c. They wanted to talk about "purifying" (vs. 25)
      - i. Like the ones who were concerned that the apostles ate with unwashen hands
      - ii. Like the ones that Jesus called whited sepulchers
    - d. They called John "Rabbi" (vs. 26)
  - 3. Had to do with baptism (judging from vs. 22 & 23)
    - a. They missed it!
    - b. No earthly water purifies!
    - c. Eph 5:26 "That he might sanctify and cleanse it with the washing of water by the word,"
- C. Division
  - 1. The Lord hates it
    - a. Hate is a strong word but that's the one God uses
    - b. Pro 6:16 "These six things doth the LORD hate: yea, seven are an abomination unto him:"

- c. Pro 6:17 "A proud look, a lying tongue, and hands that shed innocent blood."
- d. Pro 6:18 "An heart that deviseth wicked imaginations, feet that be swift in running to mischief,"
- e. Pro 6:19 "A false witness that speaketh lies, and he that soweth discord among brethren."
- 2. The Devil is in the business of chaos and destruction
  - a. There is nothing that God has built that he hasn't tried to destroy
    - i. The world in the Garden of Eden
    - ii. Marriage in divorce
    - iii. He stole God's Rainbow
    - iv. He convinced mothers to kill their own babies
  - b. You better believe the devil hates churches
- 3. So they come to ask John (vs. 26)
  - a. He was a nobody when He came to you (not true)
  - b. He stole your idea baptism (not true)
  - c. ALL men come to Him (also not true)
- 4. The Baptist answers the question

### II. THE BAPTIST

- A. A Man Can Receive Nothing (vs. 27)
  - 1. John pointed out quickly that this was NOT his ministry
    - a. Paul echoes these sentiments in I Corinthians 3:6 "I have planted, Apollos watered; but God gave the increase."
    - b. He was not out here in power of the flesh
  - 2. Moses had a similar instance
  - 3. Numbers 11:29 "And Moses said unto him, Enviest thou for my sake? would God that all the LORD'S people were prophets, and that the LORD would put his spirit upon them!"
- B. You said it yourselves!
  - 1. You bore me witness (vs. 28)
  - 2. I said I am NOT the Christ
    - a. I am not Elias
    - b. I am not "that" prophet
    - c. I am A VOICE
  - 3. Lam sent before Him
- C. John the Baptist was not surprised
  - 1. All of Israel may have been shocked by the sudden appearance of Christ
  - 2. But it was the one thing for which John had been WATCHING
  - 3. Mark 1:3 "The voice of one crying in the wilderness, Prepare ye the way of the Lord, make his paths straight."
    - a. Prepare YE
    - b. Not prepare US

- D. The Appearance of Jesus Christ
  - 1. Was John the Baptist's purpose
  - 2. Was John the Baptist's fondest wish
  - 3. He preached Christ
  - 4. We should too
  - 5. He is the Bridegroom

#### III. THE BRIDEGROOM

- A. Jewish Weddings
  - 1. Jewish vs. Roman
  - 2. Stages
    - a. Betrothed
    - b. Espoused
    - c. Married
  - 3. Romans cut the espoused portion...
    - a. We call "betrothed" engaged
    - b. But it really isn't the same thing
    - c. Not really a practical / financial element
- B. The Best Man Friend of the Bridegroom
  - 1. The friend of the bridegroom had certain duties
  - 2. But NONE of the duties involved wooing the bride away!
  - 3. No! When the BRIDEGROOM takes the vows
    - a. The FRIEND OF THE BRIDEGROOM rejoices!
    - b. This my joy therefore is fulfilled
  - 4. Why "therefore"?
  - 5. Because the BRIDEGROOM had arrived and was preaching!
- C. Increase and Decrease
  - 1. John was not sent to create a church
    - a. John was sent to store up the building materials!
    - b. What do we build buildings out of? Wood, stone, sheetrock
    - c. What does Christ build churches out of? Baptized belivers!
  - 2. John was not sent to Compete
    - a. John was sent to compliment
    - b. John was "sent"
    - c. John was NOT the authority

# IV. THE BADGE

- A. Who can speak with authority?
  - 1. I can tell you a lot about cyber security
    - a. I can speak to you quite a bit about raising cattle
    - b. Painting of a cow at Hobby Lobby..
  - 2. Vs. 31 It matters what you know

- B. The one that comes from above is above all
  - 1. Don't miss it Jesus HAS all authority
  - 2. Not speaking of the Godhead, but Jesus (Father sent the Son...)
  - 3. But if He had been sent as a servant like John
  - 4. Then He would have no authority
  - 5. But He CAME from above
    - a. Willingly of His own accord
    - b. Because He Loved the World
- C. When He speaks of Heaven
  - 1. He has firsthand information
  - 2. He is an eyewitness!
  - 3. And He is testifying to us about the ways of God (vs. 32)
- D. ANYONE who receives His Testimony (vs. 33)
  - 1. Set to his seal God is true!
  - 2. Romans 3:4 "God forbid: yea, let God be true, but every man a liar; as it is written, That thou mightest be justified in thy sayings, and mightest overcome when thou art judged."
- E. If you are Saved, you know that God is TRUE
  - 1. That the Bible is True
  - 2. Psalm 12:6 "The words of the LORD are pure words: as silver tried in a furnace of earth, purified seven times."
  - 3. Not just a little bit (by measure) but through and through!

## V. THE BIG PICTURE

- A. The Father loveth the Son
- B. He that believeth on the Son hath everlasting life
  - 1. Not hopes for everlasting lift
  - 2. But HATH
- C. He that believeth not the Son shall NOT see life
- D. But the wrath of God abideth on him
  - 1. Remains
  - 2. Destroys the error of universal salvation and soul annihilation
  - 3. Eternity in hell
