PERSONAL EVANGELISM #14 - GOD'S WORD TO THE SAVED

JESUS PAID THE FULL PENALTY FOR YOU: "Who his own self bare our sins in his own body on the tree, that we, being dead to sins, should live unto righteousness: by whose stripes ye were healed" 1 PETER 2:24, (1 COR. 15:3&4)

HIS RIGHTEOUSNESS NOW IS PLACED TO YOUR CREDIT: "But of him are ye in Christ Jesus, who of God is made unto us wisdom, and righteousness, and sanctification, and redemption:" $\underline{1 \text{ COR. } 1:30}$, (ROM. 10:4)

CONFESS HIM AS YOUR SAVIOR AND LORD: "That if thou shalt confess with thy mouth the Lord Jesus, and shalt believe in thine heart that God hath raised him from the dead, thou shalt be saved." ROM. 10:9, (MATT. 10:32)

FOLLOW JESUS IN BAPTISM: "And it came to pass in those days, that Jesus came from Nazareth of Galilee, and was baptized of John in Jordan." $\underline{MARK~1:9}$, (COL. 2:12, ROM. 6:4)

IDENTIFY YOUSELF WITH ONE OF THE LORD'S CHURCHES: "Neither do men light a candle, and put it under a bushel, but on a candlestick; and it giveth light unto all that are in the house. (16) Let your light so shine before men, that they may see your good works, and glorify your Father which is in heaven." MATT. 5:15&16, (ACTS 2:41)

WORSHIP WITH HIS PEOPLE: "Not forsaking the assembling of ourselves together, as the manner of some is; but exhorting one another: and so much the more, as ye see the day approaching." HEB. 10:25, (JOHN 20:19, REV. 1:10)

CONFESS TO GOD EVERY SIN: "If we confess our sins, he is faithful and just to forgive us our sins, and to cleanse us from all unrighteousness." 1 JOHN 1:9, (ISA. 55:7, PSALM 51:17)

STUDY THE BIBLE DAILY: "All scripture is given by inspiration of God, and is profitable for doctrine, for reproof, for correction, for instruction in righteousness: (17) That the man of God may be perfect, throughly furnished unto all good works." 2 TIM. 3:16&17,

LISTEN TO YOUR PASTOR AND BE TEACHABLE: "These were more noble than those in Thessalonica, in that they received the word with all readiness of mind, and searched the scriptures daily, whether those things were so." ACTS 17:11
