#### I. THE PREVIOUS SIX

- A. From the beginning of Chapter 16, we see seven Vials of Judgement
  - 1. The vials (or bowls) are FULL of the wrath of God REV. 15:7
  - 2. Consider again for a moment Praise God it is CONTAINED!
    - a. If the wrath of a Holy God broke forth unconstrained!
    - b. There would be nothing left!
    - c. God is NEVER "out of control"
    - d. This is not "unchecked anger" (as a man would have)
    - e. This is GOD's righteously and indignant but controlled wrath
- B. A quick summary of the first five:
  - 1. The First Vial Beast worshippers receive "noisome" and "grievous" sores
  - 2. The Second Vial Sea water becomes blood LITERALLY of a DEAD MAN
  - 3. The Third Vial All fresh water becomes blood
  - 4. The Fourth Vial Scorching heat upon earth but they refuse to repent!
    - a. Something else: Remember that the ice caps will likely melt
    - b. Al Gore said the major cities would be flooded 200' sea level rise
    - c. But remember now it's all BLOOD!
- 5. The Fifth Vial Darkness fills the earth truly becoming Hell on Earth C. The Sixth Vial (vs. 12)
  - 1. The Euphrates River dries up
    - a. It is called "the great river" five times in Scripture
    - b. It flows from Mt. Ararat 1800 miles to the Persian Gulf
    - c. A natural dividing line between the East and the West
      - i. Very deep and very wide
      - ii. It forms the eastern boundary on the promised land
      - iii. <u>ISA. 11:15</u> "And the LORD shall utterly destroy the tongue of the Egyptian sea; and with his mighty wind shall he shake his hand over the river, and shall smite it in the seven streams, and make men go over dryshod."
    - 2. But it will dry up to provide a path for the "Kings of East"
      - a. This allows these eastern armies to march over into Megiddo
        - i. Older commentaries estimated armies of 3 to 5 million
        - ii. That was back when China had only 600 million people
        - iii. These armies will join those of the west to attack God
      - b. Napoleon said of Megiddo, "[It is] the most ideal, natural battlefield in the world. All the armies of the world could maneuver their forces on this vast plain."
      - c. This is valley upon which Jesus will fight the forces of Satan
      - d. The valley will flow with blood to the horse bridles REV. 14:20
        - i. 1.5 gallons in an adult human

- ii. 1600 stadia x 5 ft deep x 10 ft wide = 48,557,520 cu ft
- iii. That's only 350,000 people not even a million
- D. Before the Seventh Vial,
  - 1. There will be sent a Powerful Drawing
  - 2. All will be given Prior Warning
  - 3. Before the world will experience the seventh Poured Judgement
  - 4. And it will all point back to this world's very Present Need

# II. THE POWERFUL DRAWING

- A. Three unclean spirits Demon Spirits (vs.14)
  - 1. The term is used throughout the New Testament for demonic influence
  - 2. <u>LUKE 11:24</u> "When the unclean spirit is gone out of a man, he walketh through dry places, seeking rest; and finding none, he saith, I will return unto my house whence I came out."
    - a. This is why you MUST replace addictions with godly actions
    - b. When you REMOVE something from a life, it leaves a gap
    - c. A gap in a wall is a VULNERABILITY FILL THE GAPS!
  - 3. "Like frogs" recall the great plagues sent against Egypt in Exodus
    - a. Remember John was viewing things with a spiritual lens
      - i. Not sure if these will be visible on Earth or not
      - ii. Even if they are visible, the beast-worshippers won't mind
      - iii. They probably will think it was awesome!
    - b. Frogs are slimy and foul truly reptilian and alien to us
      - i. Ever looked at a dog and wondered what it was thinking?
      - ii. Ever looked at a frog and wondered? No?
    - c. Frogs on the farm growing up on the pond bank
      - i. They'd hear you coming and jump in with a peep
      - ii. And then just stay below the surface, only their eyes above
      - iii. Watching and hiding and waiting
- B. These came from all three of the wicked unholy anti-trinity
  - 1. Out of Satan's mouth the Dragon
    - a. He has been cast out of Heaven and down to the Earth
    - b. Once, he had been allowed into Heaven's throneroom
    - c. <u>JOB 1:6</u> "Now there was a day when the sons of God came to present themselves before the LORD, and Satan came also among them."
    - d. But no more!
    - e. <u>REV. 12:9</u> "And the great dragon was cast out, that old serpent, called the Devil, and Satan, which deceiveth the whole world: he was cast out into the earth, and his angels were cast out with him."
  - 2. Out of the beast's mouth, that anti-Christ
    - a. Who is he? We may already know him, but probably not

- b. He shall be revealed 2 THESS. 2:1-12
- c. He works the works and wonders of Satan
- 3. Out of the False Prophet's mouth the anti-Holy Spirit
  - a. All three of the anti-trinity working together as one (vs.14)
  - b. They are bringing their armies from the corners of the globe
  - c. To fight against God. To destroy Jerusalem (where God has put His name). To destroy all things godly.

# III. THE PRIOR WARNING

- A. How can Satan think he can defeat God?
  - 1. He knows the Scriptures
  - 2. MATT. 4:5-7 "Then the devil taketh him up into the holy city, and setteth him on a pinnacle of the temple, (6) And saith unto him, If thou be the Son of God, cast thyself down: for it is written, He shall give his angels charge concerning thee: and in their hands they shall bear thee up, lest at any time thou dash thy foot against a stone. (7) Jesus said unto him, It is written again, Thou shalt not tempt the Lord thy God."
  - 3. Satan must know the Word of God says that he cannot possibly win!
- B. Ah, but don't you know that liars begin to believe their own lies?
  - 1. We know that he is a liar Jesus tells us so!
  - 2. <u>JOHN 8:44</u> "Ye are of your father the devil, and the lusts of your father ye will do. He was a murderer from the beginning, and abode not in the truth, because there is no truth in him. When he speaketh a lie, he speaketh of his own: for he is a liar, and the father of it."
  - 3. And the first lie he told? Casting doubt upon God's Word
  - 4. <u>GEN. 3:4</u> "And the serpent said unto the woman, Ye shall not surely die:"
- C. Consider too, that Jesus Christ IS the very Word of God
  - 1. <u>JOHN 1:1</u> "In the beginning was the Word, and the Word was with God, and the Word was God."
  - 2. So, Satan is jealous of Jesus and is directly casting doubt about Him
  - 3. Satan is SPECIFICALLY and CONTINUALLY lying about our Savior
    - a. Why are there so many English Bible versions? So Satan can lie.
    - b. Why are there so many "denominations"? So Satan can lie.
    - c. Why teach evolution with such VEHEMENCE? So Satan can lie.
  - 4. He HATES Jesus Christ and the Gospel
- D. And into all these preparations Satan is making, Jesus speaks (vs. 15)
  - 1. Thieves come unexpectedly...they usually don't make an appointment
  - 2. Jesus is issuing prior warning
  - 3. Since you won't know what hit you, I'm telling you now. It was me.

### IV. THE POURED JUDGEMENT

- A. When the angel poured it out he said it was "done." (Unstoppable)
- B. Many catastrophes to make all the former look small by comparison
  - 1. Thunders, lightings and a great earthquake (vs. 18)
    - a. Such as was not since men were upon the earth
    - b. No former tsunami, no way to measure it on the Richter scale
    - c. Even the FLOOD did not produce an earthquake like this!
  - 2. Jerusalem split into 3 pieces and the cities of the nations fell (vs. 19)
    - a. Not SOME of the cities, I'll point out. ALL of them.
    - b. What does divided mean? Probably not religiously from a quake.
    - c. Physically divided probably does not mean a small crack...
  - 3. EVERY island fled away and the mountains were not found (vs. 20)
    - a. Every island sunk below blood even after ice caps melted
    - b. Haiti, Cuba, Hawaii, the English isles
    - c. The mountains FLATTENED
  - 4. Great hail the weight of a talent (vs. 21)
    - a. Talents weigh ~75 pounds almost double an average cannonball
    - b. Hailstorm we experienced in Clayton, NC
    - c. Consider the destruction caused WORLDWIDE
    - d. This is God' final judgement on the earth (but not the people)
- C. And yet they will not repent! They continue to the battle (vs. 16)

#### V. THE PRESENT NEED

- A. People need the Lord today more than ever
  - 1. Satan is lying to our culture more than ever today (media/Internet/etc.)
  - 2. He is casting doubt upon the Word of God
  - 3. He is casting doubt upon Salvation through Jesus Christ ALONE!
  - 4. It's all a lie!
  - 5. JOHN 17:17 "Sanctify them through thy truth: thy word is truth."
- B. I am here to testify that Salvation CANNOT be found in any other!
  - 1. <u>ACTS 4:12</u> "Neither is there salvation in any other: for there is none other name under heaven given among men, whereby we must be saved."
  - 2. Your works cannot save you, your baptism cannot save you
  - 3. ONLY Jesus Christ can save you through the blood He shed on the Cross
  - 4. Don't believe Satan's lies. He hates you, but God loves you!
  - 5. <u>JOHN 3:16</u> "For God so loved the world, that he gave his only begotten Son, that whosoever believeth in him should not perish, but have everlasting life."
- C. Be Saved Today!
